



CAPTAINS DAY 2020

Date:

For 2020, October 10th

Elegability:

The Competition is open to all amateur Lady and Gentleman members over 18 years, and are in possession of a valid Royal Spanish Golf Federation license. To qualify for a prize, each team member must have 4 x qualifying score cards. Teams will only be comprised of the following:

- (a) One Gentleman and one lady
- (b) Two Ladies

The maximum number of participants will not exceed 140.

Categories:

There will be either two or three categories (depending on the number of participants) by the exact playing handicap of all participants, trying to include in each category the same number of players.

Registration:

1. Incriptions can be made as of September 19th and will be made in person using a pre-printed form available in the caddie master's office, or downloaded from the internet. The person making the inscription may include 2 or 4 players on the inscription form.
2. Instead of exact start times you will be asked to nominate one of three time slots, early, mid or late. Mark your preferred time slot with a 1 and your second preference with a 2.
3. The forms will be deposited in a separate box for the Captains Cup held in the caddie masters office and which will be emptied at 12:00 on the Wednesday October 7th.

As the order of play is determined by a draw THERE IS NO ADVANTAGE OF EARLY ENTRIES AND NO NEED FOR QUEING. Entries on the last day have as much chance to be drawn first as those on the first day.

Registration Fee:

Golf = 5 € per Team.

"TO BE PART OF THE DRAW FOR THE 2020 CAPITAIN'S CUP, THE REGISTRATION MUST BE PAID BEFORE THE INSCRIPTION IS CLOSED"

Green Fee for members B & C must be paid in the day of the competition.

Play Format and game rules:

18 holes stableford handicap (4BBB better ball). The tournament is played in accordance with the Rules of Golf established by the R.F.E.G. the Permanent Club Local Rules and those dictated by the Competition Committee.

Starting Order and Tee Time:

Entry list and tee times list will be published October 8th on the Notice Board, Guadalmina's website and RFGA website (Next Caddy).

Prizes:

One Absolute handicap winner. The number of prizes (one for every 7 players) in each category will depend on the number of participants. The absolute handicap winner and handicap categories will not be cumulative, with the absolute handicap winner prevailing over the handicap categories. The prizes will consist of a challenge cup and Guadalminos.

Various:

There will be NO prizegiving or lottery.

The use of buggies is allowed.

In everything that is not expressly stated in this regulation, it will be as indicated in the competition booklet.

There will be 1 "nearest the pin" for ladies (2nd hole) and 1 for men's (14th hole).

Tournament Committee:

The Committee will be formed by the Captains of men's and ladies 2020: Gary Compson and Antonia Silva assisted by the caddy master on duty.
