



DIARIO SUR CIRCUIT 2019



Place and date:

South Course, **Saturday July 27th** 2019.

Participants:

Members of the Club, amateur players of any age, may take part, provided that they are in possession of the corresponding active license of the RFEG and with national handicap, although it is limited to 36.4 for both sexes. Limited to **216 players** between all categories, with a minimum of 6 players per category, of which 108 players will be from the Diario Sur circuit and the rest of the players, members of the Real Club de Golf Guadalmina. In case of exceeding the number of players the Committee reserves the possibility of extending this number. The cut of admitted players will be by order of exact handicap.

Rules:

The tournament is played in accordance with the Rules of Golf established by the R.F.E.G. the Permanent Club Local Rules and those dictated by the Competition Committee.

As it is a tournament that belongs to an established circuit, in this case there are two regulations, the one of the circuit itself and a specific regulation for the tournament held at the Real Club de Golf Guadalmina. To know the bases of the circuit, [CLICK HERE](#).

Categories Diario Sur:

Only for finalists. 2 for MEN, 1 for LADIES, defined by the exact handicap of the players, distributing equitably the number of participants between the categories so that in all there is approximately equal number of them.

Categories RCGG:

Para socios y finalistas. 3 for MEN, 2 for LADIES and 1 for JUNIORS.

Registration:

PAYMENT ADVANCE COMPULSORY. It must be done at the **CADDY MASTER** or through the **ONLINE PAYMENT PLATFORM** ([HERE](#)) on the club website from 1 month before the tournament until 2 days before at 6 pm.

Registration fee for this competition is **5 €**.

The lists of the registered and the tee times will be exposed in the bulletin board and in the web of the club www.guadalinagolf.com and of the Real Andalusian Federation of Golf www.rfga.org (NextCaddy). The rest of the players who are not members of the Real Club de Golf Guadalmina may only compete in the competition if they had qualified in any of the previous 4 tournaments (**Los Arqueros - 15/6, El Paraiso Golf Club - 30/6, Alcadesa Golf - 6 / 7 or Cabopino Golf - 21/7**).

Play Format:

Individual Stableford play format over 18 holes.

Tee boxes:

Yellow for MEN and Red for LADIES.

Starting list and tee times order:

There will be two SHOT GUNS, one at **9:00 h** (for **MEMBERS**) and another at **3:00 p.m.** (**FINALISTS DIARIO SUR**), the allocation of the holes will be made taking into account the handicap game and other considerations such as availability of buggy and specific requests that will be tried to please.

Prizes:

The prizes of the circuit are collected in the internal bases. About the prizes of the regulation tournament of the Real Club de Golf Guadalmina, they will be the following ones: Winner and second classified Handicap in each category, and absolute Scratch prize of Ladies and Gentlemen and Indistinct Junior. The Scratch and Handicap prizes will not be cumulative, with the Scratch prevailing over the Handicap. The prizes will consist of a dozen balls, as well as a commemorative trophy.

Tiebreaks:

In case of ties, it will be resolved in accordance with the Book of Competitions of the Real Club de Golf Guadalmina.

Tournament Committee:

Hans Wielaard, a representative of the Diario Sur and Marc Mueller - Baumgart, assisted by the Caddy Master.

Various:

The prize giving presentation will be held from **8:30 p.m.**, along with the celebration of a **cocktail**. There will be a raffle of sports equipment donated by Diario Sur among all participants, who have not obtained a prize for classification, who attend the awards ceremony.

Buggies are allowed (no for juniors). It is recommended to reserve it by email to operations@guadalinagolf.com.

Note:

In order to be awarded with a handicap prize, or to qualify in a handicap category, different from the (absolute) scratch category, Players must provide with 4 valid results obtained during the previous 365 days prior to the celebration of the prize giving ceremony. To this effect, valid results is the what has been defined in 2016-2019 EGA Handicap System.
