

RCGG MATCH PLAY CUP - DOUBLES HANDICAP MEN 2020

Preamble:

Common rules for Doubles Club Match-Play Championship Men.

Place:

North and South Courses. If one of the courses is closed the competition will be played on the available course.

Participants:

All male amateur players of an adult age category and members of the club with a valid license from the Royal Spanish Golf Federation, may take part.

Categories:

One indistinct category for pairs of two men.

Dates and starting times:

Qualifier: The Handicap Classification of a tournament to be determined. For 2020 it will be:

Play & Win, Saturday, 31st of October 2020 on the South Course

Match Play: Once the Match Play draw is established, the tee-times of the matches will be posted on the bulletin board.

The match will be played on the date and time dictated by the committee. All players will be responsible for communicating the result of the match to the committee by this stipulated date. Otherwise, the committee will consider the match as not played and both pairs will be disqualified.

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to modify schedules. In case of changes, these will be communicated in due time.

Registration:

The admission of entries will be subject to the rules of the qualifying competition. Those interested must register for the qualifying competition and indicate their intention to participate in the Copa Match Play before the start of the competition.

Registration fee:

The registration fee will be **5 Eur** per player (10 Eur for the pair)

Rules of the game:

The championship will be played in accordance with the rules approved and in force by the R.F.E.G., the local rules of the club and the local rules that the tournament committee dictates.

Classification:

The pairs with the best 16 results (handicap) in the qualifying competition will qualify for the Match Play table. The best pair, will face the pair ranked No. 16, the 2nd against No. 15 and so on as described in the attached table.

In the event there are less than 16 pairs in the qualifying tournament, all pairs will be classified for the match-play rounds. In this case, the first pair classified will go directly to the Round of 8 until the full draw is established.

Tee Boxes:

South Course: 58

North Course: 54

Format of Play:

It will be played on 18 holes under the rules of Four Ball - Better Ball Match Play Handicap (see Competition Booklet 2.b.2 v.)

Handicap points:

For the calculation of the Playing Handicap the table of 100% of the Playing handicap percentages is used.

The player with the lowest playing handicap plays with zero. The other players receive 90% of the difference between their own playing handicap and that of the player with the lowest playing handicap.



Example: Player 1 hcp 6.4, player 2 hcp 12.4, player 3 hcp 15.8 and player 4 hcp 16.9.

Player 1, on the South course and from the Tees 58 has a playing handicap of 8 and player 2, 15.

The difference would be 7 points and applying 90% = 6.3 = 6. For player 3 the playing handicap is 19, the difference to the best player being 11 and applying 90% = 9.9 = 10.

For player 4 the playing handicap is 20, the difference to the best player being 12 and applying 90% = 10.8 = 11.

Tiebreaker:

All matches must be resolved immediately after the completion of the established holes. Being a handicap competition, the players must continue on hole 1 and successive until one of them wins a hole. The players receive the points that correspond to the same holes in the standard 18 hole contest as described above.

Various:

- By mutual agreement, pairs may choose another date <u>PREVIOUS</u> to the stipulated date
- By mutual agreement, pairs may choose another course than the stipulated one.
- The pairs of the Match Play Cup will be able to book a tee time in advance in the Caddy Master
- The absence without notice from any match will mean the loss of the same.

Awards:

The winning pair of the Match Play Cup Doubles will have the privilege of inscribing their names in the Club Honor Board.

The first three pairs classified will receive a voucher for purchases in the Pro-shop or restaurant of the club respectively of 50%, 30% and 20% of the sum of the registration fees.

Tournament Committee:

It will be formed by three members appointed by the Competition Committee, who are Hans Wielaard, Christina Birke and Alfonso Cruz-Conde Tangil.
