



North & South Tournament 2020

Place:

North & South Course.

Dates:

December 7th (South Course) and 8th (North Course) for 2020.

Participants:

All amateur members of the Club who hold a valid license issued by the RFEG are eligible to play in this competition. Exact handicap limited to 36, limited to 120 players.

In case that the number of inscription exceed the number of places, the entry order will be by handicap, from lowest to higher.

Categories:

The number of categories will depend on the number of players. Men's category, ladies' and Junior (21 years or less during the year of the celebration of the tournament).

Play format:

The tournament will be played over 36 holes as Handicap Individual Stableford on two consecutive days, 18 holes will be played each day.

Competition rules:

The competition will be played according to the Rules of Golf approved by the RFEG and currently in effect, as well as the permanent rules established by the RFGA and the Local Club Rules dictated by the Competition Committee.

Tee box:

South
Gentlemen 58, Ladies 47.

North

Gentlemen 55, Ladies 48

Registration:



Registration will open not less than 30 days prior to the day of the competition. Registration will close at 18:00 pm 2 days before the start of the competition.

Registration fee:

Registration fee, 5€ for adult members and 3€ for junior members, it is mandatory to make the payment in advance.

Tee times & Starting Order:

Tee times will be determined by ascending handicap order (lowest handicap first). On the 1st day by categories and ascending handicap order regardless Ladies, Gentlemen and Juniors and on the 2nd day in reverse category order and scratch score obtained the previous day, alternating Ladies, Gentlemen and Juniors.

No-Play-Offs:

There will be no play-off and the ties will be decided as follow:

Handicap Competition – Lowest exact handicap prevails.

Scratch Competition – Highest exact handicap prevails.

Buggies

The use of golf carts is allowed (not for juniors). It is recommended to reserve the buggy, sending an email to (cadymaster@guadalminagolf.com)

Juniors will not be allowed to use buggy.

Prizes:

Handicap and scratch prizes. The number of prizes will depend on the number of participants & categories (one prize every 7 players). Ladies's & Gentlemen Scratch Champ, will put their names in the Honor Board.
