Elegability:

The Competition is open to all amateur Lady and Gentleman members over 18 years, and are in possession of a valid Royal Spanish Golf Federation license. To qualify for a prize, each team member must have 4 x qualifying score cards. Teams will only be comprised of the following:

- (a) One Gentleman and one lady
- (b) Two Ladies

The maximum number of participants will not exceed 140.

Categories:

There will be either two or three categories (depending on the number of participants) by the exact playing handicap of all participants, trying to include in each category the same number of players.

Registration:

1. Incriptions can be made as of September 30th and will be made in person using a pre-printed form available in the caddie master's office, or downloaded from the internet. The person making the inscription may include 2 or 4 players on the inscription form.

Registration Fee:

Golf = **5 € per person.**

Green Fee for members B & C must be paid in the day of the competition.

Play Format and game rules:

18 holes stableford handicap (4BBB better ball). The tournament is played in accordance with the Rules of Golf established by the R.F.E.G. the Permanent Club Local Rules and those dictated by the Competition Committee.

Starting Order and Tee Time:

Entry list and tee times list will be published October 29th on the Notice Board, Guadalmina's website and RFGA website (Next Caddy).

Prizes:

The registration fee will be distributed among the winners of the categories

Various:

There will be prizegiving and lottery.

The use of buggies is allowed.

In everything that is not expressly stated in this regulation, it will be as indicated in the competition booklet.

There will be 1 "nearest the pin" for ladies (2nd hole) and 1 for men's (14th hole).

Tournament Committee:

The Committee will be formed by the Captains of men's and ladies 2021: Roger Hughes and Lorena Ricondo assisted by the caddy master on duty.
