



## Shool Match Play

**Course:**

North & South Course

If one of the courses is closed, the match will take place on the other course.

**Dates:**

**Players:**

All the members of the R.C.G Guadalmina Golf School with national handicap.

**Classification:**

The qualifying tournament will be through the Monthly School Competition that will be held on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> of October on the North Course. The players with the best 16 results (handicap) will qualify for the Match Play Tournament. The best one will face the classified nº 16, the 2nd against the 15th and so on.

**Categories:**

Only one category.

**Tees:**

Benjamines Masculino Campo Sur 50 / Campo Norte 48

Alevines Masculinos Campo Sur 55 / Campo Norte 50

Otras Edades Masculino Campo Sur 58 / Campo Norte 55

Todas las jugadoras Femeninas Campo Sur 50 / Campo Norte 48

**Inscriptions:**

Players must register for the October Monthly Competition (10/11/2020), which will be the tournament to qualify to enter on the Match Play tournament. This Tournament receives the MAJOR distinction.

**Format:**

Players will play under Match Play Handicap conditions during this competition.



### **Handicap Points:**

For the calculation of the Playing Handicap the table of 100% of the Playing handicap percentages is used. The player with the lowest playing handicap plays with zero. The other players receive 3/4 of the difference between their own playing handicap and that of the player with the lowest playing handicap.

Maximum handicap difference between opponents: 18 strokes/points. (For higher handicaps, this will be applied).

Example: Player 1 hcp 8.7 and player 2 hcp 12.4. Player 1, on the South Course and from the tees 58 has a playing handicap of 11 and player 2, 15. The difference would be 4 points and applying  $\frac{3}{4}$  it is 3.

### **Starting Times:**

Once the Match Play Tournament has been established, the start times of the matches will be posted on the notice board.

The Committee of the tournament reserves the right to modify schedules. In case of changes, these will be communicated in advance.

### **Play-Offs:**

All play offs must be resolved immediately. As they are handicap events, the players must continue through hole number one and successive until one of them wins a hole, and the player who has points, will have them in the same holes as in the normal round of the test.

### **Prizes:**

The winner of the School Match Play will have the privilege of registering their name on the Club's Honor Board and will receive a customized golf bag, with the club's logo and their name engraved.

The runner-up of the School Match Play will receive a trophy.

### **Committee:**

It will be made up of three members appointed by the Competition Committee, which from 2015 are Marc Mueller-Baumgart, Gunilla Lindstrom and the teacher who is present on the day of the test.

**Points:**

This Match Play is valid for the School's annual Ranking. The winner of the qualifier will receive 20 points.

The rest of the participants (including the winner), will receive 30 points for obtaining a result equal to the value of the field (36 stableford points or 72 medal play strokes), adding or subtracting 1 point for each stroke made below or above this result. . In no case a player could receive negative points in a competition.

Whoever qualified for 1/8 will receive 2 extra points. Whoever advances to the quarterfinals 4 points, to the semifinals 8 extra points, the runner-up will receive 15 points and the winner 20 points. Points will never be cumulative, a player who reaches the final will not get the 2 points for having qualified for the eighth, the 8 for being a semifinal, etc. 20 points will be awarded directly to the winner.

**Others:**

The use of a caddy will only be allowed if he/she is a player of the School. Spectators and companions must remain at a distance of 50 meters from the players. To qualify for the award and add points, the use of the School uniform is mandatory.

The absence without prior notice to any match will mean, in addition to not being able to play the next Monthly Competition, the withdrawal of the points achieved in this competition.
