



# TEXAS SCRAMBLE MENSUAL

**Location:** North Course.

**Dates:** Monthly

## **Participants:**

Open to all amateur members of the Club over 18 years of age who hold a valid license issued by the Real Federación Española de Golf.

To qualify for a prize every member of a team must have 4 qualifying score cards.  
Teams must not consist of more than two men.

## **Categories:**

A maximum of three categories; the division of handicaps will be defined on the day of the competition based on the total number of players.

At the Captain's discretion there may be only two categories. The division of the team handicaps will be adjusted accordingly.

## **Registration:**

From December 2020 all inscriptions must be done through internet on the club's website, the competition will open 10 days before the playing day and will close 2 days before the day of the competition at 18:00PM.

## **Registration Fee:**

5€ registration fee per person must be paid before starting the competition.

## **Format:**

Texas Scramble Delaney Rules for three or four players teams:

- 10% of the total slope handicaps of the team (3 players 15%)
- 4 drives each + 2 free (3 players minimum of 5 drives each with a maximum of 7)
- Placing in rough and bunker.
- All players can drive on every hole, then decide which ball is to be taken



## TEXAS SCRAMBLE MENSUAL

- The player whose ball is elected CANNOT take the next shot
- Play continues the same way, with the player whose ball is chosen on each shot NOT taking the next shot
- When the ball is on the green, ALL players may putt

### **Starting Order and Tee Time:**

The order and start times will be determined by the event organizers.

### **Prizes:**

Guadalminos for using in the pro-shop and restaurant.

There will be no prize giving and the prizes of the winner can be picked up two days after the competition has finished in the Caddy master.

### **Sanctions:**

Any player unable to play must notify **the caddymaster by email and their playing partners at least 12 hours before their tee time start.**

If this player doesn't communicate this information, he/she will not be allowed to play the next Texas Scramble.

### **Competition Committee**

The committee for this tournament is form by George Novelli, Jan Novelli, Hans Wielaard and the support from the Head Caddy Master on duty.

•In order to be awarded a prize, players must provide with 4 valid results obtained during the previous 365 days prior to date of the competition.

•To this effect, valid results is what has been defined in the World Handicap System.
