



School Competition RCGG

Location: South, North and Pitch & Putt Courses

Dates: Once a month, except when the Paco Open is played, the dates will be settled by the Competition Committee

Participants: All male and female amateur member from RCG Guadalmina (Spanish or foreign) and their guests (in this case limited to six annual events) with a valid license from the Real Federación Española de Golf who belong to the Club's Golf School (sometimes adults may also participate when they are needed it). There must be a minimum of six and a maximum of 120. If this number is exceeded, the 120 players with the lowest handicap will participate.

Categories: One category for players with a national handicap and another for those who do not have it. In the category of players with a national handicap this will be limited to 36 for Ladies & Gentlemen. The smallest players, even having a national handicap, may also choose to play in the "non-national" category when for some reason they do not feel capable of playing on the Long course.

Format: The event will be played in the national handicap category over the 9 or 18 holes, depending on the decision from the committee, and in the non-national handicap category at the 9 short holes in the Stableford or Medal Play format, to be decided by the committee on each occasion. The non-national handicap category will always play on the Pitch & Putt course.

Rules of the game: The championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of the game approved and in force by the R.F.E.G, the permanent ones of the Club and by the Locals dictated by the Competition Committee.

Inscriptions: Inscriptions will start approximately 30 days before the day of the tournament at the Real Club de Golf Guadalmina and will end at 18:00 p.m two days before. The Competition Committee has the right to admit more registrations until the time of the tournament.



Registration Rights: The registration fee will be the one determined by the Competition Committee at the time. In general it will be free. Guests will pay the corresponding rate approved by the committee, unless they are members of clubs that has agreement with ours.

Starting order: The start time will be made in ascending order from lowest to highest handicap, with exceptions if the Committee decides so.

Tie-breaks: In case there is a tie, the committee will proceed as the competition's book dictated.

Buggies: The use of golf cars is forbidden.

Prizes: Trophy and sports equipment for each winner. There will be an equal number of scratch and handicap prizes. In each case it will be defined by the Committee. The guests, in case of obtaining a prize, will have a special one, of the same category as the general one, but they will not occupy the place of a member prize, unless they are members.

Committee: It will be made up of three members appointed by the Competition Committee, from 2021 the committee members are Alejandro Ponce de Leon, the teacher present on the day of the test and the Caddymaster.

Others: Caddy is not allowed. Spectators and companions must remain at a distance of 50 meters from the players. To qualify for any award, the use of the school uniform is mandatory. With the result from each student in every competition, including the Open de Paco, a School Ranking will be made. Club members who are not members of the school can NOT qualify for the guest category more than twice a year, except for those who do not have a national handicap who will be able to play as many times as they want as they do not have the possibility to play other competitions of the club.
