



YELLOW BALL COMPETITION

Course:

SOUTH Course (over two days).

Dates:

30th Nov and 1st of December 2020

Participants:

All Ladies and Gentlemen amateur players (Spanish or foreign) who hold a valid license issued by the R.F.E.G. are eligible to participate. Players must be older than 21 years of age at the start of the tournament.

Teams will consist of 2 ladies and 2 men.

Categories:

There will be either two or three categories (depending on the number of teams) by the exact handicap of all participants, trying to include in each category the same number of teams.

Play Format

The competition will be played over 36 holes (2 rounds of 18 holes) in the Stroke Play Stableford full handicap Format over two consecutive days CALLED ECLECTIC.

Game Rules:

The tournament will be played in agreement with the Rules of Golf established by the R.F.E.G. and currently in effect, as well as those pertaining to the R.F.A.G. and the “Local Course Rules” dictated by the Competition Committee.

Two scores count on each hole:

- Holes 4, 6, 10 and 16 the lowest playing HCP score be counted plus the best score from one player.
- Holes 5, 8, 13 and 18 the second lowest playing HCP score be counted plus the best score from one player.
- Holes 2, 9, 11 and 12 the third lowest playing HCP score be counted plus the best score from one player.
- Holes 1, 3, 14 and 15 the highest playing HCP score be counted plus the best score from one player.
- Holes 7 and 17 the TWO best score COUNTED.

If two players have the same playing handicap the order must be established before play.

On Tuesday, try to improve the result from Monday.

**Tees:**

58 Men and 50 for Ladies.

Registration:

1. Incriptions can be made as of November 13th (Friday) and will be made in person using a preprinted form available in the caddie master's office, or downloaded from the internet. The person making the inscription may include 4 players on the inscription form.

2. Instead of exact start times you will be asked to nominate one of three time slots, early, mid or late.

Select your preferred time slot.

3. The forms will be deposited in a separate box for the Yellow Ball in the caddie master's office and which will be emptied at 12:00 on the Friday November 27th. The order of play is determined by a draw

THERE IS NO ADVANTAGE OF EARLY ENTRIES AND NO NEED FOR QUEING. Entries on the last day have as much chance to be drawn first as those on the first day.

Maximum 128 Players

Registration Fee:

The registration fee is determined by the Tournament Committee for 2020 and is 10 € per team

Starting Order and Tee Times:

Entry list and tee times list will be published November 28 on the Notice Board, Guadalmina's website and R.F.G.A. website (Next Caddy).

Tie Breakers:

In the event that there is a tie for any of the other places and/ or prizes, the team with the lowest exact handicap will prevail.

Prizes:

The number of prizes (one for every 7 players) in each category will depend on the number of participants. The prizes will consist of Guadalminos.

Tournament Committee:

Will be formed by the captains of 2020: Antonia Silva and Gary Compson assisted by the Caddy Master on Duty.
