



Club Championship 2020

Location:

South & North Courses

Dates:

For 2020 October 24th (South) and 25th (North)

Participants:

All amateur members of the Club who hold a valid license issued by the Real Federación de Golf Española de Golf are eligible to play in this competition

Categories:

Three categories for Men and two for Ladies' **of all ages including juniors**. The division of players will be in order to get similar numbers of players in each category. In the case that there should be less than 10 players in any category, the committee may reduce the number of categories.

Play Format:

This tournament will be played over 36 holes as Stroke Play on two consecutive days. 18 holes will be played each day.

Competition Rules:

The competition will be played according to the Rules of Golf approved by the R.F.E.G and currently in effect, as well as the **Club permanent local rules** the Local Club Rules dictated by the Competition Committee.

Tee box:

Gentlemen South Course (61) North Course (56)

Ladies South Course (55) North Course (50)

Registration:

Registration will open not less than 30 days prior to the day of the competition at the R.C.G. Guadalmina Club House. Registration will close at 6:00pm 2 days before the start of the competition.

Registration Fee:

There will be **NO ENTRY FEE** for Club members participating in this competition plus the assigned green fee.

Tee Times & Starting Order:

Tee times will be determined by ascending hándicap order (lowest hándicap first). On the first day by categories and ascending hándicap order, playing Ladies together and Gentlemen together and preferably by categories and on the second day in reverse category order and scratch score obtained the previous day.

**Play-Off:**

Golf Carts:

The use of golf carts is allowed in this competition.

Prizes:

First prize for each scratch winner in each category , Absolute Scratch winner for Ladies Gentlemen will get a replica of the Trophy and their names will be engraved on the Challenge Trophy.

There will be no prize givings in order to stop the Covid-19 disease from spreading, winners can pick up the prizes in Alvaro's Office after the day of the competition.

In order to be awarded a category, different from the absolute scratch category, Players must provide with 4 valid results obtained during the previous 365 days prior to the celebration of the prize giving ceremony. To this effect, valid results is the what has been defined in the World Handicap System.
