Participants

All amateur female members of the Club and guests invited by the sponsor are eligible to participate. Junior players are permitted to compete without paying the registration fee; however, they will not be eligible for prizes.

The tournament is limited to 112 players, of which 20 spots are reserved for the sponsor's guests.

Players representing the sponsor will not count towards national teams in the **Nations Cup**.

Individual Competition Categories:

The total number of registered players, will be divided into three categories, ensuring an even and equitable distribution.

Registrations:

The registration will be managed **through the Claphouse platform**, opening 20 days prior to the event and closing at 3:00 PM on the Saturday preceding the competition. This allows for the proper organization of tee times.

Registrations players will be accepted in the order of registration, up to a maximum of 92 participants.

The Caddy Master will update the list of registered teams daily on the ladies' notice board via Claphouse.

Entry Fee

The registration fee is € 6, payable before the round begins.

The sponsor will have 8 guests free of charge, and the remaining 12, up to the 20 spots allocated to the sponsor, will pay €100 including a shared buggy. If the sponsor does not use all of their allocated spots, these will be used to accommodate club member players on the waiting list.

Format

Individual Stableford.

Start Times

Shotgun starts at 09:30

Prizes

- **GOLVI Tournament:** Prizes awarded to the top three players in each category.
- **Nations Cup:** Open to regular participants of the Ladies' Section. The winning team will be the one with the highest average Stableford score, calculated by dividing the total team points by the number of players representing each nation.

Financial Settlement

Any financial surplus from the event will be used to offset potential shortfalls in other similar tournaments.

Should a surplus still remain, the competition coordinator will determine how it will be allocated.

Competition Committee

The committee for this event will consist of The Vice Captain Miriam Gravalos , Suzanne Norell and one Member of The Club Competition Committee. They will be supported by the Head Caddie Master on duty.

Additional Information

- A **Welcome Pack** will be offered to all participants.
- A **refreshment station** will be set up at Hole 6, courtesy of Golvi.
- Prizes will be awarded for:
 - **Closest to the pin** 11th hole
 - **Longest drive** on the fairway at Hole 10
 - The most fanny picture award, from pictures taken by the “official photographer” , if any lady refuse this, please inform the photographer.
 - Puttin green contest (one ball only) from 14:00 until 15:30
 - A special award titled “**The Fighting Lady**” will be presented to the player with the lowest Stableford score in any of the categories
- The **Awards Ceremony** will include a cocktail reception and a **women’s fashion show**.

"In all matters not expressly provided otherwise, the provisions of the Club's Competition Book and the interpretation made by the Committee shall apply.

Note regarding RCGG prizes: In order to be eligible for a prize based on handicap classification, or scratch classification in a category other than the absolute category, the player must have 4 valid results obtained during the past year up to the date of the prize-giving ceremony.

For these purposes, a valid result is as defined in the EGA Handicap System 2016-2019."
