

Location: North Course.

Dates: Monthly

Participants:

Open to all amateur members of the Club over 18 years of age who hold a valid license issued by the Real Federation Española de Golf.

To qualify for a prize every member of a team must have 4 qualifying score cards.

Teams must not consist of more than two men.

Categories:

A maximum of three categories; the division of THEM will be defined on the day of the competition based on the total number of players.

At the competition committee discretion there may be only two categories. The division of the team will be adjusted accordingly.

Registration:

All inscriptions must be done through internet on the club's website and clapphouse, the competition will open 7 days before.

The registration will close 2 days before at 18:00.

Registration Fee:

5€ registration fee per person must be paid before starting the competition.

Format:

Texas Scramble medal Hdcp ,Rules for three or four players teams:

- Scramble 4 players: 25%, 20%, 15%, 10% of the handicap from lowest to highest.
- Scramble 3 players: 30%, 25%, 15% of the handicap from lowest to highest.
- Placing in fairway, rough, penalty area and bunker .Size of relief area, one car length not nearer the hole and in the same area of the course as the place of rest of the chosen ball,



- All players tee off with their own ball. For the next shot, the most suitable ball is chosen from those that have been played. From that point on, all the players play again and so on until the hole is finished. The number of strokes, for each hole, will be that of the first ball that is holed out.
- There must be a minimum number of tee shots used per player during the Round:
- For teams of 4; four tee shots per player.
- For teams of 3; five tee shots per player.

Tee Boxes

Men Tee 55
Women Tee 48
Men over the age of 75 can choose a Tee

Starting Order and Tee Time:

The order and start times will be determined by the event organizers.

Prizes:

The prizes will be credited in the winner's accounts.

Sanctions:

Any player unable to play must notify the caddymaster by email and their playing partners at least 12 hours before their tee time start.

If the player doesn't communicate this information, the sanctions will be as per the club's "no show regulations "

- •In order to be awarded a prize, players must provide with 4 valid results obtained during the previous 365 days prior to date of the competition.
