DATES

They will be announced in due time with as much advance notice as possible. Always on weekends or public holidays when no other club competition open to members is scheduled.

PLACE

South / North Course

PARTICIPANTS

All RCGG member players may take part; professionals, amateur men and women (Spanish or foreign) with a valid RFEG license, with a maximum exact handicap of 36, limited to 92 players.

The Tournament Committee, at its discretion, may modify any condition of these regulations to ensure the proper conduct of the tournament.

If the number of participants exceeds the limit, a waiting list will be created in order of registration.

In case registrations exceed available spots, the competition will be organized according to the order of registration.

NOTE: RCG Guadalmina Academy junior members may not participate in Saturday competitions, except on days when there are no classes.

REGISTRATION

Registration must be done through the "Clapphouse" App, the Club's website, or at the Caddy Master, starting at 7:45 a.m. 14 days before the event and closing at 3:00 p.m. two days prior to the event.

REGISTRATION FEE

The registration fee is €5 for all Junior, adult amateur, and professional players.

For team or pairs competitions, the fee is €5 per player.

Players must also pay the applicable Green Fee according to their membership status.

GAME FORMAT

Formats will aim to be handicap-qualifying whenever possible.

Unless otherwise indicated, rounds will consist of the standard 18 holes in their usual order.

For Scramble competitions, handicaps are adjusted as recommended in Appendix C of the Handicap System.

- 4-player Scramble: 25%, 20%, 15%, 10% from lowest to highest handicap.
- 2-player Scramble: 35% of the lower handicap + 15% of the higher.

In 4-player Scramble, each player must tee off at least 4 times, with 2 additional free selections.

In 2-player Scramble, each player must tee off at least 8 times, with 2 additional free selections.

NOTE: In Scramble format, the ball is to be placed within one scorecard length from the selected ball's position (fairway, rough, bunker, or penalty area), not closer to the hole and within the same area of the course.

RULES OF PLAY

The Championship will be played according to the Rules of Golf approved and in force by the RFEG and the Local Rules of RCGG.

For all matters not explicitly regulated herein, the RCG Guadalmina Competition Book will apply.

RECOMMENDED TEES

Ladies: South 50 / North 48 Gentlemen: South 58 / North 55

NOTE: Players may choose any other authorized tees by notifying the Caddy Master in advance. To be eligible for the scratch prize, players must play from the recommended tees.

TEE TIMES AND STARTING ORDER

Groups will be assigned based on handicap and category from lowest to highest, unless otherwise decided by the Committee. Times will be posted on Clapphouse and the website.

The DIGITAL SCORECARD will be used and verified at the Caddy Master. Players unfamiliar with the system must report to the Caddy Master to input their scores manually.

CATEGORIES

One category will be established for every 20 adult amateur players, which is the maximum allowed per category.

If the number of registered players is not a multiple of 20, proportional averaging will be used to create the necessary number of categories, none exceeding the maximum limit.

Junior players will have their own category if at least 6 participate. If fewer than 6 register, they may still play but will not be eligible for prizes, and their registration fee will be refunded.

Professional players are subject to the same criteria as Junior players regarding minimum entries, prize eligibility, and fee refunds.

In team events, a single category will be established for up to 20 teams.

Teams may include adult amateurs, juniors, and professionals. However, teams with one or both members being professionals without a handicap may participate but will not be eligible for prizes.

CATEGORIES AND PRIZE DISTRIBUTION - "PLAY & WIN" PAIRS

ALL PARTICIPANTS – PRIZE POOL DISTRIBUTION PER CATEGORY

1st Scratch: 27.5%
1st HCP: 27.5%
2nd HCP: 20%
3rd HCP: 15%
4th HCP: 10%

NOTE: Professionals without a handicap will not be eligible for prizes in pairs competitions.

Prizes are non-cumulative. Scratch takes precedence over handicap. Results will be published on the website and app on the day of the competition for any potential claims.

BUGGIES

Juniors are not allowed to use buggies, except in pairs competitions where they will be considered adults if paired with one.

SEVERAL

To be eligible for a handicap prize, players must have recorded 4 valid results in the 12 months prior to the award ceremony.

A valid result is as defined in the World Handicap System (WHS).

TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE

The Committee will consist of Mr. Miguel A. Gutiérrez Oneto, Alfredo Calle Vega, José Manuel Martínez Domínguez, assisted by the on-duty Caddy Master. The Committee is authorized to interpret these regulations and to adopt any supplementary measures it deems appropriate for the smooth running of the tournament.
