South Course

PARTICIPANTS

Eligible participants include RCGG member players, guests of members, and sponsor guests, male and female amateurs over 21 years of age. Spanish players must hold a valid RFEG licence, and foreign players who do not hold an RFEG licence must provide an up-to-date handicap certificate issued by their federation. Maximum field: 180 players.

CATEGORIES

Men's First Category: handicap up to 12.4

Men's Second Category: handicap from 12.5 to 26.4

Ladies Category: Single Category (limited to handicap 28.4)

The maximum exact handicap will be 26.4 for men and 28.4 for women; higher handicaps will be reduced to these limits.

FORMAT OF PLAY

The competition format will be Individual Stableford.

RULES OF PLAY

The championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf approved and in force by the Royal Spanish Golf Federation, together with the Local Rules of RCG Guadalmina. Any matters not expressly regulated in these Rules shall be governed by the RCG Guadalmina Competition Book.

RECOMMENDED TEE MARKERS

58 for men and 50 for women

NOTE: Any other approved tees may be chosen provided the Caddy Master is informed in advance. To be eligible for the scratch prize, players must play from the recommended tees.

REGISTRATION

Registration must be completed through Nextcaddy, Claphouse, or the Club website from 7:45 a.m., 14 days before the event, until 3:00 p.m. two days before the event.

ENTRY FEE

Participants shall pay the following amounts:

- RCGG members: applicable green fee according to membership category A, B or C, plus €10
- Non-members: €100

Payment must be made through the ONLINE PAYMENT PLATFORM in Claphouse or directly with the Caddy Master.

TEE TIMES AND STARTING ORDER

Consecutive starts in ascending handicap order, from lowest to highest. Requests may be accommodated for a maximum of two players wishing to play together (for example, to share a buggy). Tee time will be determined by the player with the highest handicap. Full groups may not be created. The sponsor may create four-player groups for its guests based on the highest handicap in the group. The Committee may modify tee times at its discretion if deemed necessary.

TIE BREAKS

In the event of a tie, the Club Competition Book shall apply.
