DATES

They will be announced in a timely manner as far in advance as possible. Always making it coincides with the seasons that are the reason for the championship.

PLACE

SUR Course

PARTICIPANTS

All RCGG member players can participate; professional, male and female amateurs (Spanish or foreign) with a valid license from the RFEG, with a maximum handicap of 36 and limited to 132 players.

In case of exceeding the number of participants, there will be a waiting list in order of registration. In the event that the number of registered exceeds the number of places available, the competition will be organised according to the order of registration.

CATEGORIES

Adult Amateur (Men and Ladies)

Separate categories shall be established for Men and Ladies, with a maximum of two (2) categories per gender, depending on the number of entries at the close of registration:

30 entries or fewer: one (1) single category shall be established for that gender.

31 entries or more: two (2) categories shall be established for that gender.

When two (2) categories are established for a gender, players shall be allocated according to exact handicap order, distributing the number of entries evenly between both categories.

Mixed Junior Category (minimum of 6 entries)

Junior players shall have their own category provided that a minimum of six (6) entries is reached. If this minimum is not reached, they may still take part in the competition without being eligible for prizes, while retaining the right to participate in the draw.

Mixed Professional Category (minimum of 6 entries)

The participation of professional players shall be governed by the same criteria established for the Junior category, both with regard to the minimum number of entries and eligibility for prizes, as well as the right to participate in the draw.

The Competition Committee shall be entitled to modify the categories depending on the number of entries.

REGISTRATION FEES

That the registration fee will be 10€

Registration must be done through the "claphouse" App, the Club's website or at the Caddy Master, from 7.45 a.m. 14 days before the race and until 2 days before at 3.00 p.m.

GAME MODE

It will be played over 18 holes in the individual Stableford modality

RULES OF THE GAME

The Championship will be played in accordance with the Golf Rules approved and in force by the RFEG, Local Rules in force in the RCGG and the policy of rhythms of play.

RECOMMENDED EXIT BARS

Ladies 50

Caballeros 58

NOTE: Any other approved bars can be chosen by announcing it in advance to the Caddy Master. To qualify for the scratch prize, they must play from the recommended bars.

SCHEMES AND ORDER OF DEPARTURES

Tee-off at shotgun (09:00) , the holes will be designated by draw.

The groups will be assigned in order of handicap and categories from lowest to highest.

PRIZE

Prizes shall be awarded by category, depending on the number of entries in each category at the close of registration.

Amateur Categories (Men, Ladies and Junior)

20 entries or fewer:

1st Gross (Scratch): Trophy + €50 account credit

1st Net (Handicap): Trophy + €50 account credit

21 entries or more:

1st Gross (Scratch): Trophy + €50 account credit

1st Net (Handicap): Trophy + €50 account credit

2nd Net (Handicap): Trophy + €40 account credit

Professional Category (Mixed)

Prizes in the Professional category shall be awarded exclusively on a Gross (Scratch) basis, according to the number of entries at the close of registration:

10 entries or fewer:

1st Gross (Scratch): Trophy + €50 account credit

11 to 20 entries:

1st Gross (Scratch): Trophy + €50 account credit

2nd Gross (Scratch): Trophy + €40 account credit

21 entries or more:

1st Gross (Scratch): Trophy + €50 account credit

2nd Gross (Scratch): Trophy + €40 account credit

3rd Gross (Scratch): Trophy + €30 account credit

Prize Allocation Criteria (Non-cumulative)

Classification prizes shall not be cumulative.

If the same player achieves both a Gross (Scratch) prize and a Net (Handicap) prize, only the Gross (Scratch) prize shall be awarded, and the Net (Handicap) prize shall pass to the next eligible player.

AWARDS CEREMONY

A cocktail will be offered during the awards ceremony in the Clubhouse, (depending on how the situation is with the current Restaurant), one hour after the delivery of the last card. There will also be raffles for sports equipment among the attendees.

BUGGIES

The use of buggies for the Junior category is prohibited.

TEST COMMITTEE

It will be made up of a Competition Committee and the Director of Operations assisted by the Caddy Master of Service.

The Committee will be empowered to interpret these regulations, as well as to adopt any complementary measures it deems appropriate for the best development of the race.

PRIZE

In addition to the prizes for each test, there will be a single ranking that will include all categories. The 5 best classifieds will be recognized, based on the sum of the 4 tests. For those members who play all 4 tests, only their 3 best results will be counted. This will be applied to the detriment of non-resident members, who will have the same opportunities.

- 1st Driver
- 2nd Wood 3
- 3rd Hybrid
- 4th Putter
- 5th Sand wedge

SCORING SYSTEM

Each player will accumulate double the Stableford points they obtain in the three best events in which they participate, that is, if a player obtains 34 points, 68 points will be accumulated for the ranking.

AWARDS CEREMONY

Coinciding with the awards ceremony of the 4th test, we will take the opportunity to give the prizes of the Ranking classification.
