



ROTARY TOURNAMENT 2026

DATE

11 April 2026

VENUE

South Course

PARTICIPANTS

Amateur male and female players over 21 years of age may participate. Spanish players must hold a valid RFEG license and foreign players who do not hold an RFEG license must present an updated handicap certificate from their federation. Maximum number of participants: 120 players.

CATEGORIES

Two mixed categories defined by playing handicap, distributing the number of participants equally between the established categories.

FORMAT OF PLAY

The competition will be played as Individual Stableford.

The Electronic Scorecard will be mandatory.

RULES OF PLAY

The championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf approved and in force by the Royal Spanish Golf Federation, and the Local Rules of RCG Guadalmina. Any matters not expressly covered in these regulations will be governed by the RCG Guadalmina Competition Rules Book.

RECOMMENDED TEE MARKERS

Tees: 58 for men and 50 for women.

NOTE: Players may choose any other approved tee markers provided they inform the Caddy Master in advance.

REGISTRATION

Registration must be completed through Nextcaddy, Claphouse or the Club website from 07:45 hrs, 14 days before the competition, until 15:00 hrs two days before the event.

ENTRY FEE

Participants will pay the following fees:

- RCGG members: the green fee corresponding to their membership category (A, B or C) plus €10.
- Non-members: €100.

STARTING ORDER AND TEE TIMES

Shotgun start at 09:00. Starting holes will be drawn, respecting the handicaps of each match. If a player requests to play in the same group as another (this intention must be indicated in the comments), for organisational reasons such as sharing a buggy, the Committee may grant this request provided they adapt to the playing handicap corresponding to the player with the higher handicap, limited to two players.

The Committee may modify the starting holes at its discretion if deemed necessary for any reason.

TIE BREAK

In the event of a tie, the provisions of the Club Competition Rules Book will apply.

PRIZES

For the top 2 players in each category.

Best Gross Prize – Men

Best Gross Prize – Ladies

Gross prizes are not cumulative. To be eligible for the gross prize, players must play from the recommended tees. The gross prize will prevail over the handicap prize regardless of position.

COMMITTEE

The tournament committee will consist of the Competition Committee, assisted by the Caddy Master on duty.

The Committee is empowered to interpret these regulations and to adopt any additional measures it deems appropriate for the proper running of the competition.
